

# COMMUNITY/PARTNER OPTIONS TO UTILIZE GIS PLANNING

The Governor's Office of Economic Development has contracted with GIS Planning for our sites and building database which also includes access to demographic, labor force, wage, talent pool, business, and consumer expenditure data.

Being a GOED partner, you can:

- List available properties in your community or region on the state site
- Access all the data mentioned above
- Run property and data reports for your community or county, export them in multiple formats, or link directly to them from your own website

## OTHER OPTIONS

If you would like to have an interactive property and/or data system on your own website, versus simply linking to information on GOED's site, there are options available to you.

### LOCAL EDITION

GIS Planning has created a local edition of their platform that provides the property and data reports without the interactive mapping. The local edition is available to you at a significant cost savings and is an easy way to have community data at your fingertips.
